DO YOU KNOW THE **TERROIR CONCEPT?** We explain it!

Terroir' is a french origin term, without translation in just one word, involving a variety of factors which are responsible and interfere in wine making. Its definition from french refers to a limited extension of land considered, from its agriculture suitability point of view and mainly, to the wine production.

Talking about "terroir" means talking about several factors such as topography, geology, pedology, drainage, climate, microclimate, grape varieties, human intervention, culture, history and tradition. Therefore, the concept of "terroir" comprises a wide range of environmental conditions, but also the interaction, in a particular geographical area, between natural elements (soil composition, local climate, thermal amplitude, attitude, terrain relief, sun exposure, winds, humidity, rainfall volume and distribution, soil diainage) and human factors (the choice of the grape varieties, the agricultural techniques used at the vineyards, the wine making methods and its aneinn).

Terroir' will then be this set of natural and human factors that have a decisive influence on the performance of the vineyard and on the quality of the grape, taking part in the find when character and assuring its typical origin, as a kind of a regional signature.
